

- Recycles Cardboard
- Recycles Magazines, phone books, paper
 - Recycles Aluminum
 - Recycles plastic
- Environmental services uses environmentally preferable chemicals
 - Recycles paint and thinner waste
 - SMMC uses low VOC or no VOC paint
- Use of low mercury bulbs and moving toward compact fluorescents with remodels and new
 - Moving towards zone light changes
 - Use of electronic ballasts
 - All steam lines insulated
- Low flush toilets (1.6 gal) on new and remodeled areas
 - Low Flow aerators in faucets
- SMMC free of mercury in all clinical areas
 - Recycles mercury
 - Recaptures condensate from steam lines
- Cooling tower uses electronic pluses to treat bacteria
- Power plant is the most energy efficient possible at this time
 - Does not bag grass
 - Tower 1 is landscaped to use less H2O
 - Tower 1 windows are Low E Glass
 - Tower 1 uses outside light sources
 - Low lighting option switches
- Pulper-can reduce waste by 85% of its original volume
- Grease Pick up- sold to companies and in composting.
 - Harvesters-Donating surplus product inventory
 - Vegetable Scrap/trimmings goes to a local farmer
 - Pallets-all are returned to the vendor.
- Computers and equipment is donated to churches and schools or company that salvages all useable parts
 - X-ray film recycled
 - Batteries Recycled
 - Blue Wrap Recycled
